PRESS LICENSE PLATE APPLICATION NRS 482.3672

A resident of this state who is regularly employed as an editor, reporter, or photographer by a newspaper, television or radio station may register one passenger vehicle, or non-commercial truck using Press License Plates. If you leave the employment of the newspaper, television, or radio station, you must surrender your Press License Plates to the Department.

A letter verifying the applicant is a regular employee of the newspaper, television or radio station from the news director, editor or publisher must be presented with this application. The letter must contain the following information:

- a. The name, title and contact information of the news director, editor, or publisher.
- b. A statement indicating the applicant is employed <u>regularly</u> by the newspaper, television, or radio station.

Press license plates must be ordered in person at a full-service DMV office.

The initial fee for Press License Plates is \$36.00 which includes a Prison Industry fee. There is an annual renewal fee of \$10.00. These fees are in addition to all other applicable fees.

If your vehicle is currently registered, you have the option of maintaining your current vehicle registration expiration date or renewing for a full twelve 12-month period. Credit for any unused portion of your current registration will be allowed. In applicable counties, if you are renewing for a full 12-month period, and your previous evidence of compliance with emissions standards was obtained more than 90 days ago, the vehicle must be reinspected prior to registration.
