



RADIO AMATEUR LICENSE PLATE APPLICATION

NRS 482.375 & NAC 482.380

An owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of the State of Nevada, and who holds a valid Amateur Radio Station License issued by the Federal Communications Commission, may apply for Radio Amateur license plates. Radio Amateur license plates are stamped with the words "RADIO AMATEUR" and the Radio Amateur call sign of the applicant, assigned by the Federal Communications Commission. Radio Amateur license plates may only be used on private passenger vehicles, trailers, travel trailers, or on a noncommercial truck.

A copy of the applicant's current Federal Communications Commission license must be submitted with this application.

The initial fee for Radio Amateur license plates is \$36.00, which includes a Prison Industry fee. There is an annual renewal fee of \$10.00. These fees are in addition to all other applicable fees.

A waiver of the renewal fee may be granted if the applicant satisfies requirements of the Department and states under penalty of perjury that he will assist in communications during local, state, and federal emergencies and be the holder of an unrevoked and unexpired official amateur radio station license. A request for waiver of renewal fees can be made on Department form, Waiver of Amateur Radio License Plate Renewal Fees (SP-50).

If the radio amateur license issued by the Federal Communications Commission expires, is cancelled, or revoked, the Radio Amateur license plates must be returned to the Department of Motor Vehicles for cancellation.

Your Radio Amateur license plates will be mailed to the current address of record maintained by the Department. If you ordered your Radio Amateur license plates via mail, your plates will be forwarded to the DMV location specified on the application and you will be notified, by mail, when they are available to be picked up. If your vehicle is currently registered, you have the option of maintaining your current vehicle registration expiration date or renewing for a full twelve (12) month period. Credit for any unused portion of your current registration will be allowed. In applicable counties, if you are renewing for a full 12-month period, and your previous evidence of compliance with emissions standards was obtained more than 90 days ago, the vehicle must be re-inspected prior to registration.
