



NEVADA NATIONAL GUARD LICENSE PLATE APPLICATION NRS 482.376

A Nevada resident who is a member of the Nevada National Guard may apply for National Guard license plates. Each applicant may request two (2) sets of Nevada National Guard License Plates. The plates may be used on passenger vehicles and non-commercial trucks.

The fee for a National Guard license plate is \$5.00, plus a Prison Industry fee of \$1.00. These fees are in addition to all other applicable fees.

The applicant and his/her commanding officer must sign this application. Proof of enlistment must also be submitted with this application. The Nevada National Guard License plate may be personalized (page 2).

If your vehicle is currently registered, you have the option of maintaining your current vehicle registration expiration date or renewing for a full twelve (12) month period. Credit for any unused portion of your current registration will be allowed. In applicable counties, if you are renewing for a full twelve (12) month period, and your previous evidence of compliance with emissions standards was obtained more than ninety (90) days ago, the vehicle must be re-inspected prior to registration.
