Approval of February 25th 2021 Meeting Minutes

Review of Nevada Legislature Proposed Bills as it Relates to the Board

Discussion on Assembly Bill 349

- Dick Mills (Wreckers); This bill has mostly to do with smog laws
- JD Decker (DMV/CED); Bill submitted by Howard Watts that does a couple things:
 - o Primarily reduces ten dollar fee for inspectors to register at alternate stations other than their primary location
 - o Closes some of the classic car loopholes such as no commercial use cars
 - Authorizes the department to create regulations to allow for remote sensing for emissions check
- JD Decker (DMV/CED); Explains that remote sensing is mobile equipment that reads emissions from vehicles as it passes by. We currently have the equipment to use for EPA regulations. This bill would allow the department to create regulations that would make use of that technology.
- New bill also smog exempts new vehicles from two years to three years.

Discussion on Assembly Bill 446

• This is a classic cars exemption that has died in committee.

Discussion on Senate Bill 29

• Dick Mills (Wreckers); This was a bill that allowed the department to authorize third parties to issue salvage titles on behalf of the department. The Governor has already signed this bill into law. Law goes into effect October 1st.

Discussion on Assembly Bill 114

• Dawn Bobbert (Insurers); Bill did not get to a vote in time.

Discussion on Senate Bill 204

- Dick Mills (Wreckers); This bill authorizes the department to establish an electronic branch office.
- JD Decker (DMV/CED); This bill does not affect any of the groups in the board.

Vote to Support or Oppose Bills

Dawn Bobbert (Insurer); Opens any motion to support or oppose any bill

Dick Mills (Wrecker); States that the legislation is well into the process so there is no need to support or oppose any bill.

Steve Yarborough (Garages); Seconds that there is no need for support or opposition to any bill at this point.
