A. Peter Kruger (ETC) – I'm wanting to highlight a discussion I had about a year ago with Administrator Decker, one specifically concerning a proposed NAC regulation change for testing equipment. As you know the NV2000 analyzer has basically been the tailpipe and OBD testing device for eons and what we're going to ask for in a proposed regulation change is not to change any of that, you still would have to be able to do as the regulation requires – all tailpipe and OBD testing - so an analyzer will still be required, but, we're wanting emission stations to have in addition to and be allowed to use a "tablet type analyzer" on vehicles equipped with OBD. The current approved manufacturer

of the NV2000 has such a device as well as some other manufacturers not currently approved here in Nevada. We think it would speed up the process and when a current analyzer goes down you would have a backup for OBD only testing as well. Additionally, there was a message sent out in the VID on March 29, 2024, mentioning that the Windows 7 operating system is no longer supported. Many of our members have that kind of equipment and they are looking at having to upgrade. Of course, they'll always have to upgrade one piece of equipment but if this were approved, they wouldn't necessarily have to upgrade both/multiple pieces of testing equipment. I'm wanting to get this topic back on the agenda and I will provide some recommended language to Administrator Decker next week. Also, one other thing I do need to mention, NAC 445B 5052, 5056, and 5075 has lots of wording, in our estimation, that is no longer valid. For example, current language in subsection 2 requires that a station have a replacement analyzer within one day. To my knowledge that has never happened and again using a tablet might help there. And in the warranty information there is some language we think could be reviewed. Thank you.
